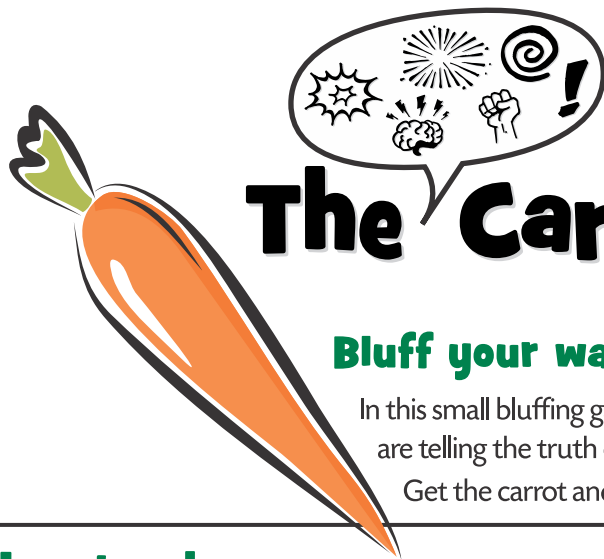




The Carrot Game

Bluff your way to the carrot!

In this small bluffing game you are trying to determine if your opponents are telling the truth or lying about which vegetables they have.

Get the carrot and you win! *Or do you?*

How to play:

Deal each player 4 cards: 1 of each of the 4 types. Each card will be either a vegetable or will be blank.

Players place their cards face down in front of themselves.

On your turn, you ask another player about one of their vegetables. They look at the card type, place an answer token on it, and announce either that they have it or that they don't.

But – *Are they lying? Do you want their card?* If so, you can trade for it.

When a player has run out of answer tokens, the game ends and all cards are revealed.

Whoever has the carrot is the winner! Unless they're not?



Do you have the carrot?

36 tokens; 6 per player

1 turn marker
